II Program Standards

The following standards pertain to particular cognitive, motor, behavioral and social skills that are associated with the educational process of the allied health program that you plan to pursue:

Radiologist Assistant

The Radiologist Assistant student must be able to:

1. **Coordination**

Gross Motor - ability to walk, bend, crawl, lift, stoop, stand, push and pull routinely

Mobility - ability to move about

Fine Motor - eye/hand coordination ability

2. **Senses**

Vision – normal, corrected, color discrimination

Hearing – normal, corrected or audible

Touch - average tactile

3. **Physical**

Ability to lift more than 50 pounds routinely

Work several hours without a break

Have full use of both hands, wrists and shoulders

Ability to stand for long periods of time

Assist patients on and off examining table

4. **Cognitive**

Communicate effectively with patients and health care professionals.

Organize and accurately perform the individual steps in a Radiographic procedure in the proper sequence.
